

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where is Iron Mountain?

We are in the beautiful Ouachita National Forest region of west central Arkansas.
For driving directions, map to 118 Iron Mountain Lane, Mena, AR 71953.

When is the pre-registration deadline?

Pre-registration is due to CMA on or before 12/1. (Postmarked by 11/21 if mailed.)

Can I come if I did not pre-register?

Yes. Registration will be available on-site for \$85.00 Students & Adults and \$57.00 Volunteers & LIT.
Registration forms for minors require a parent/guardian signature. The form should be completed in advance and brought with the student if a parent/guardian will not be with them. Registration is open 12/29 at 3:00-6:00 PM.

How do I qualify for the LIT/Volunteer registration rate?

Leaders in Training (LITs) are people ages 18-25 who, by attending Flame On, agree to be the back and legs of the event. They will serve by setting up and tearing down chairs, cleaning up, taking out trash, and helping out wherever the Volunteer Leader calls them.

Volunteers are adults who pledge to support Flame On in the same role as LIT attendees.

Volunteers and LITs should look at the lower rate as an opportunity to serve the event with their work as well as their finances. These groups should always take the initiative if any volunteer jobs need to be done at the event.

How do I find out more about volunteering?

You will be contacted by email on the variety of volunteer job opportunities available for you to serve. An email invitation will be sent with a complete list of volunteer positions available for 'Flame On 2019.'

How early can we arrive?

Doors will open on December 29th at Noon with Registration opening at 3:00 PM.
Early arrivals will need to make lodging arrangements offsite until December 29.

If I stay off-site is there a discount?

There is not a discount for those staying off-site.

Can I send more than one Group Pre-Registration form if I have additions?

Yes. Note on the form that this is an addition to an existing group.

Can group members pre-register separately?

Yes. Individuals pre-registering separately will need to include the correct information on their form for "Group" to be included in the Group packet.

Can we transfer a pre-registration to a different participant?

Yes. Send a completed registration form for the new attendee with a note of who is being replaced. Funds can be transferred at the local level without penalty. Processing a refund from National will result in a \$20 cancellation processing fee.

Can group members arrive separately?

Yes. The Group Leader is the only person needed to check a group in.
Individuals registering upon arrival will need to provide a completed registration/health/release form (including adults) and proceed to the on site registration station.

What if someone in my group cancels and I cannot find a replacement?

Pre-registration fees for the cancelled attendee can be processed in several ways, including: transfer to a student outside of your group, applied towards a CMA donation, or refunded if cancelled by 12/21 for a cancellation fee of \$20. Contact us at events@cmausa.org to discuss the options and make changes to your Group pre-registration packet.

What payment method can be used?

We accept check, money order, Mastercard, Visa, and Discover. Please do not mail cash.

Can we purchase T-shirts at the event?

Yes. T-shirts will be available for purchase during the event for \$16.00, while supplies last.
